

AVAILABLE ONLINE THROUGH NZ UNIFORMS | SIZING SAMPLES AT THE SCHOOL OFFICE

At Southland Adventist Christian School we want to develop students who are respectful and take pride in their school. We believe that this sense of school pride can be developed through the way our students wear and take care of their school uniform. Outlined in this booklet are the standards which we expect from our students.

Our school uniform is as follows:

Shirt

Year 1-6 students wear the blue blouse/shirt with the school emblem. Year 7-8 students wear the white blouse/shirt with the school emblem.



Culottes
Girls wear tartan culottes.

All students can wear our navy-blue woollen jersey with the school emblem.



Shorts

Boys wear navy blue shorts. There are different options available for the junior and senior boys.





Jacket

All students can wear a navy-blue jacket with the school emblem. The softshell option is only available in larger sizes. Jackets are to be worn outside only.



Socks

Boys wear navy-blue long woollen socks. These are to be pulled up to the knee. Girls wear plain navy long socks or plain navy tights.



Shoes

All students wear black, leather shoes. Options for styles are shown below. Different styles are accepted provided they are black, leather school shoes with no other colours on them and are not trainers or sports shoes.

In summer students have the option of wearing black roman sandals.



Sports Uniform

Sports uniform is worn on the day students have Physical Education or when students are representing our school for a sports event. The sports uniform is the navy-blue polo shirt with the school emblem, navy-blue sports shorts with the school emblem and normal navy-blue socks or tights. Students wear sports shoes with their sports uniform. Ensure shoes are appropriate for running and playing sport.



Hats

During morning tea and lunch time in summer (Term 1 & Term 4) all students must wear either the navy-blue bucket hat or navy-blue "Aussie Style" wide-brimmed hat.



Hair

All hair longer than shoulder length must be tied up. This is to help prevent the spread of head lice. All hair ties must match our school colours.

Winter Warmth

During winter, students are permitted to wear long-sleeve thermal clothing under their uniform provided they are either plain white, navy or black (fitting in with our school colours). Students may also wear plain white, navy or black hats, scarves or gloves while they are outside.

Other Information

No other items beyond what are listed in this booklet are to be worn to school. If your child is out of uniform for any reason a note must be provided. If students are wearing the incorrect or non-uniform items without a note, they will be issued with a blue slip.

We appreciate your support in ensuring our students are dressed in the correct uniform.
